- An extensive list of resources, including books, articles, videos, FAQs, and more to come

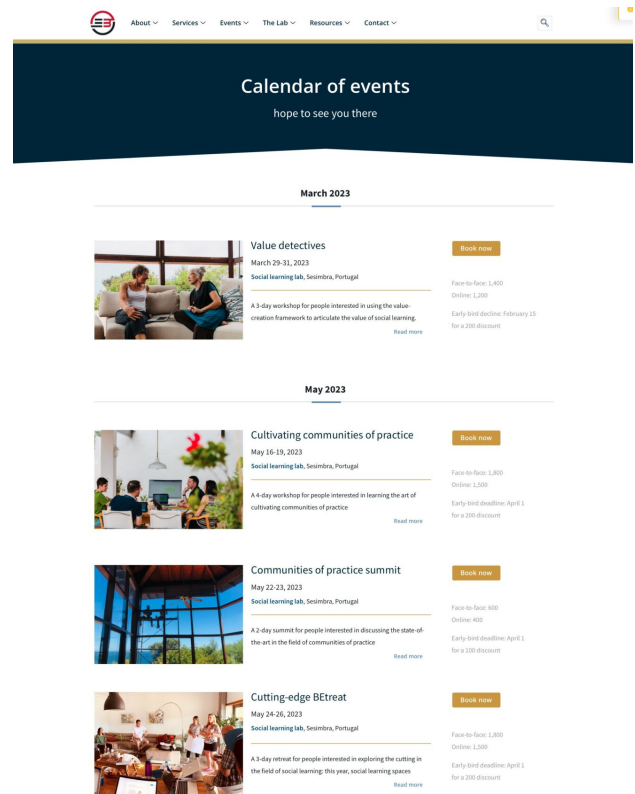
## Our 2023 calendar
